

1. *Smoking*—Smoking is not permitted in any residence hall on the Colby campus, nor is it allowed within twenty-five (25) feet of any residence hall. It is expected that all residents, guests, and College employees inside or within 25 feet of a residence hall will adhere to this policy. Students violating this policy can expect disciplinary action, increasing in severity for each occurrence, including but not limited to warnings, written notices, probationary status, and potentially more severe sanctions should violations be repeated. The College Affairs Committee has imposed the following sanctions:

In Dorm Offenses:

- First Offense: \$150 fine for smoking of any kind
- Second Offense: Housing probation
- Third Offense: Removal from College housing

Offenses Outside the Building:

- First Offense: A written notice
- Second Offense: A written citation and \$50 fine
- Third Offense: Housing probation
- Fourth Offense: Referral to Judicial Board
